American Red Cross Community Blood Drive

Thursday, July 9, 2026

The American Red Cross *will conduct a Blood Drive at church on the above date.* Right now, Red Cross blood products are being distributed to hospitals as quickly as donations come in. URGENT:

“Overall, the Red Cross national blood supply has fallen by more than 25% since July 1 2025. Blood product distributions to hospitals are outpacing the number of blood donations coming in, which is rapidly drawing down the blood supply.

The Red Cross is working with hospitals around the clock to meet the blood needs of patients – but can’t do it alone”.

Face Masks are optional during the Drive.

- If you are 17 years of age, weigh at least 110 pounds, and are in general good health, help the Red Cross meet their goal of 41 units.
- To make your appointment, or for information about types of donations, medical or travel eligibility, go to “www.redcrossblood.org”. At the site you’ll also find out the most recent safety requirements.
- Donations by appointment; no walk-in or entry without appointment. Regular donors, your last appointment must have been 56 days ago (or 8 wks). All CDC health protocols will be in place: temperature at entry, face masks required, hand sanitizing and equipment & beds sanitized.

“RapidPass” ... Donors with appointments are encouraged to complete their pre-reading and health history on-line the day of the appointment on July 9.
